


Perceptions of improving vs. worsening conditions have fallen sharply since September (source: Nat'l PAC cohort)




The rate of new infections of COVID-19 is decreasing

The rate of new infections of COVID-19 is increasing


Within the Nat'l PAC cohort, the upward trend in advance planning peaked in October, and then declined a bit. But we never got out of the single digits.






Norwegian audiences are more likely to get vaccinated right away, but some will wait

When a federally approved COVID-19 vaccine is available to the general public, do you expect to get vaccinated....




